



Day One

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

The image of God gives us value. We're not the same as the animals. We are made like our heavenly father. How does this effect how you view yourself and others around you?

Reflection: Human beings as God's representatives. What does it mean to be a good steward of God's creation? Is there a danger we end up worshiping creation? How is God challenging you regarding your interaction with God's creation? Is he calling you to change any habits that damage his creation unnecessarily? If so, lay them before God and ask him to guide you in your response to what he's teaching you. Prayer.

Day Two

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

Be fruitful and multiply. This is characterized in *deovox* as a privilege. Do you agree? Is it a mandate for all marriages, or a privilege to be exercised?

Reflection: If male and female reflect God's design, what follows from this? God has a purpose for your life. What is that purpose? Try and be specific in your answer. Have you lost your way in living out God's purposes for your life? If so, ask for his mercy, strength and wisdom to guide you back to his divine call on your life. Prayer.



Day Three

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

The Divine Image. ***The best definition includes such ideas as our mental and spiritual faculties, along with our self-consciousness, intelligence, creativity and sense of moral responsibility.*** In what ways do you look like your heavenly father? Write some ideas below.

Reflection: ***The divine image that each of us possesses grounds identity and purpose and gives us our basis for political and ethical conduct.***

Some of us struggle with the idea of identity. Who are we? And what are we here for? How has the passage informed you of who you are and what you're here for?

Christian ethics is founded on the principle that human beings are made in God's image and should be treated accordingly. How is God challenging you regarding your treatment of other people? Choose one area of your life that you know isn't the way it should be. Confess, and ask God for guidance on how to move forward in this particular area.
