



Day One

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

An inch of truth makes the lie hard to spot. What is the difference between a half-truth and an outright lie? Which, generally speaking, is more damaging? Be honest, do you lie? Or are you tempted to tell half-truths? How is God challenging you regarding your honesty?

Reflection: *Adam and Eve hide.* What do you do to hide from God? What effect does it have on your relationship with others, and with God? A devotional time is a time to meet with God face to face. If you're hiding from God, take courage and lay your worries, sins, burdens before the throne of God, and ask for his presence and his forgiveness. He loves you. Prayer.

Day Two

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

God is presented as mean-spirited, not generous. What causes you to lose sight of who God is, and to blame him for your circumstances? What causes you to become angry with God, and how does that affect your relationship with him? Read I Timothy 6:18. James 1.5. 2 Corinthians 9.5. Write some reflections in the box below.

Reflection: The world can be a bruising place. Our vision of who God is and what he's like is under assault every day. Catch a new vision of God's wonder by reading a psalm. Try one of these and allow it to lead you to worship. Psalm 8, 18, 23 or 100. Prayer.



Day Three

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

Adam blames Eve. What do we learn from Adam's behaviour? Why is the very act of blaming others a reprehensible one? If you know you're someone who is prone to casting blame elsewhere, then confess it and write some reflections below. Perhaps write a prayer of confession, and ask for God's strength to change.

Reflection: **Autonomy.** The value our society places above almost every other. How does God view our autonomy? If freedom has limits, what are they? What is the appropriate use of our autonomy and in what ways does your trust in God fit with your ability to make choices? It's a deep subject that throws up all kinds of responses. Take some of your thoughts, and turn them into prayers to God.
