Reflection: *Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.* Are you currently facing trials, and struggling to find joy in them? If so, commit them to God and ask for his wisdom and his presence to give you joy. Prayer

Day Two

Listen to the episode. Read the following question, and write your answers in the box provided.

Wisdom takes insights gleaned from the knowledge of God's ways and applies them in the daily walk. What's your understanding of wisdom? See Job 28; Proverbs 1.7; 2.6-7; 3.19-20. Write some thoughts below.

Reflection: What is the relationship between obedience and wisdom? How does walking in obedience express a wise life? How is God challenging you regarding obedience? And do you need to ask for greater wisdom in order to become obedient? If so, spend some time seeking God's wisdom on a specific issue where you feel out of your depth. Prayer.

Day Three

Listen to the episode. Read the following question, and write your answers in the box provided.

Because the LORD disciplines those he loves, as a father the son he delights in. How have you been disciplined by God? What is your reaction to the idea that God disciplines those he loves? Write some thoughts below.

Reflection: The double-minded. Is God convicting you regarding your faith in him? Is he calling you to greater commitment through this passage? God is about calling, not guilt, so if God is convicting you of being “double-minded” then simply come before him and confess. He loves you and desires relationship. He does, however, want all of you, not just part. Take time to consider how God is speaking to you through this passage. Prayer.
