Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

Half the population of the globe lives on less than 2 dollars a day. (Some sources claim that it is just 1 dollar a day) Write down some thoughts in response to that statistic. Start with emotions. Then some ideas.

Reflection: The poor are forced by their circumstances to trust God. How does this affect your view of the poor? If you have been in a state of real material need, did it effect your spiritual life? How? On this first day, try thinking through what it's like to be poor, so that your only hope is that God will somehow help you, save you. How does that effect your view of the character of God?

Listen to the episode. Read the following question, and write your answers in the box provided.

The poor are seen as possessors of the kingdom. How does this alter your view of what the kingdom of God involves?

Reflection: William Wilberforce: How can we live in houses like this when others are living in boxes? What do you think of this response? How do you respond to the needy in your society? How is God challenging you in your giving to those in need? Take some time to consider carefully how God is speaking to you regarding the ways in which you give to those less fortunate.
