



## Day One

Listen to the episode. Read the following question, and write your answers in the box provided.

**Prejudice.** How do you respond to this word? Write down some ways in which you're prejudiced. Take a good look into your soul, and confess those attitudes that reveal prejudice towards certain kinds of people.

**Reflection: The rich receive preferential treatment because of the way they look.** Based on your reflections above, simply come before God to confess those areas of weakness you know you have. Ask God for forgiveness for treating people differently according to how they look, speak, dress. Ask for a heart of compassion for those who, because of their circumstances or attitudes, you find hard to love. Prayer.

## Day Two

Listen to the episode. Read the following question, and write your answers in the box provided.

**The poor aren't just materially poor, they're the ones who trust God.** Have you experienced material need in your life, and if so, how did it effect your spiritual life? Write some reflections below.

**Reflection: We gather around ourselves people who look like us, who act like us. We don't meet with those we consider to be outside our grouping. We tell ourselves we care about those who are different, but never actually spend time with them.** Is favouritism simply outright prejudice, or is it more subtle? Is God challenging you to draw near to those who are different from you? Do sports with a group you don't normally mix with? Meet up with a crowd from work who are just completely different from you? Ask God to show you who in your life he is calling you to love, someone who is different and possibly difficult to relate to. Ask for courage to take action and actually reach out. Prayer.
