Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

What is the difference between knowledge and wisdom? Write some reflections below. **OR I asked to know the highest truth/ And what I was told/ Is to let own self be true.** India Arie. Is self-knowledge important, or is it a distraction?

Reflection: Wisdom isn't hidden, it's visible in the lives that your teachers lead. And not just leaders, but church members also. How does wisdom show itself in a believer's life? Is there a person you know who you consider wise? What qualities does s/he have? Write some of them down. Ask God for strength to develop some of the most important characteristics. Prayer.

Day Four

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

Humility. Meekness. What are these qualities? How are they developed?

Reflection: **Envy: a feeling of begrudging the success of another person.** Are you envious of someone in particular? Do you find it difficult to be satisfied with the life God has given you, or are you constantly looking at others and comparing yourself? Take some time to think through where the envy is coming from. Confess, if appropriate. Sit and enjoy the knowledge that you are his beloved child. Don't do anything, just sit and enjoy being loved. Allow this to lead you to worship. Prayer.

Listen to the episode. Read the following statement, and write your thoughts in the box provided.

Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it. Peace must be pursued. Write some thoughts on the idea of pursuing peace.

Reflection: Wisdom leads to peace. Take some time to read verse 17-18 again and again. Think through the list of virtues described in the verse. Meditate on each one. Chew it over. Ask God to develop these qualities in you.

If you're facing significant conflict, ask God for wisdom that leads to peace. Ask him to show you how to love those with whom you are in conflict.
