Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

They say that evil prevails when good men fail to act. What they ought to say is “evil prevails.” Even if you disagree with the statement as a whole, do you agree with the first half? What challenge is there if you agree with it? Write some thoughts below.

Reflection: When you add salt to food, it changes the taste of the entire dish. As salt in the world, how are you “changing the taste” around you? Whose lives are you affecting? In what way? How is God using you? Spend some time specifically praying for those you are impacting in a positive way. Perhaps a work colleague. Or a relative. Pray that God’s kingdom would come in their lives. Prayer.

Day Five

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Do you intend to use your beautiful voice to praise the Lord, or change the world? William Pitt in Amazing Grace. Are Christians called to do both? How have you seen the world changed by Christians? Write down the names of a few Christians who have had a profound effect upon the world. How do they inspire you?

Reflection: We must be seen to carry the life of God within us. Does this challenge you?

For the shy: If you’re a shy person, ask for God to show you how you can still be a person who clearly lives for God, without feeling the pressure to be someone you’re not. God isn’t asking for every Christian to become Billy Graham. He simply calls for faithfulness, whatever that looks like. Be encouraged.

For the more confident: Into what new areas is God calling you to express your faith? Is it an overt witness to the gospel? Or is God calling you to action that is more low key and less explicit? Ask God for guidance on where he’s taking you to be salt and light in the world. Prayer.
