Listen to the episode. Read the following question, and write your answers in the box provided.

You can sell almost anything with the word "sex." Why do you think this is? Write some thoughts below about the power of sex.

Reflection: When it reads, "look at a woman lustfully," the grammar communicates the sense of looking at the woman *with the aim of desiring her*. We always have a choice. And when we fall, we have further choices about how far we fall. Today, a simple challenge: if you're struggling with lust, ask God for forgiveness and then seek the one who came bringing transformation. Jesus the Messiah. He knows you intimately and he's with you every moment of every day. Even when the temptation to lust assails you. Enjoy God's grace poured out for you today.
