Reflection: What does the Bible teach on love? Matt 10.37; 22.37; Luke 6.27; 10.27; 16.13; Jn 14.15; 14.23; Jn 15.9; Rom 13.10; Eph 3.18; I Jn 4.8; I Jn 4.10 When you think about love, what role do emotions play? In reading the above references, how often do you see emotion mentioned as a vital factor? Take a couple of verses from the list, and meditate on them. Think about them through the day, and ask God to help you love people today that you find difficult. Prayer.

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

How does common grace – God's love and care for ALL his creatures - motivate us to love those on the outside? Write some thoughts below.

Reflection: Loving our enemies is utterly counter-intuitive. How is it even possible to do this? Spend some time before the Lord bringing to mind just one person in your life who would be considered an "enemy." Pray for that person. Try to find a way of expressing kindness to him/her this week. Eg. Help him/her out at work. Volunteer to help out in a group s/he leads. Ask God for his supernatural power to overcome negative emotions and hurt feelings often associated with those we deem "enemies." Prayer.
