Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

Some professions get all the movies made about them, don't they? What's your favourite movie genre and why? What kind of qualities are displayed by the characters who tend to inhabit your favourite genre? Are you attracted to certain qualities and not others? Write some reflections below.

Reflection: The Hebrew meaning of the word behind the text tells us to accept the guidance of God and to obediently follow God's will. However, later in the episode, we're also told that meekness sometimes includes appropriate anger and action in response to injustice.

Although these seem contradictory, they can be held together. Which one is God emphasizing in your life right now? Are you being called to greater obedience and the acceptance of God's guidance, or are you being challenged to take action in response to injustice? Pray over your thoughts and bring them before God for guidance. Prayer.

Day Four

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

Blessed are those hungering and thirsting for righteousness. What's your understanding of the word "righteous" after listening to the episode? Write down some thoughts.

Reflection: What does "hungering and thirsting" look like in your life? As you look at the world, and more specifically, the relationships in your life, in what ways do you hear God calling you to greater hunger and thirst for his righteousness? If you have become apathetic and lacking in faith that God can bring transformation, then take some time to confess. Ask God to give you a hunger and thirst for his kingdom to come. Prayer.

Day Five

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

Mercy is the active expression of compassion. Who would you describe as a merciful person? What characteristics does s/he have that inspire you? Write some thoughts below.

Reflection: It's also closely linked to forgiveness. What's the link between mercy and forgiveness? How do you respond to the beatitude in which mercy comes to those who are merciful. How does that challenge you? Have you lost compassion for those around you? Is God calling you to a greater practical expression of mercy, by volunteering, reaching out in some way, or praying for people God places in your life? Try to be specific with one challenge you believe God is placing before you. Ask him to guide you and give you strength to take action. Prayer.
