



### Day One

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

**If you want to be perfect, go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me.** How does generosity to others help us spiritually in orienting us toward our heavenly father? Write some thoughts below.

**Reflection: He challenges his disciples to take a long hard look at everything they consider valuable. What is valuable to you?** Write a list above of the five most valuable “things” you have. It can include people and “immaterial” things, like health or time. Look at that list. What does it tell you about yourself? Now offer the list to God, and ask him for strength to love him more than the entire list put together. Spend time this week thanking him for his goodness to you. Perhaps you could fast, to demonstrate your devotion to him. Prayer.

### Day Two

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

**Money has tremendous power to entangle the heart. It's not neutral. It sets itself up as a god, whether we choose to acknowledge it or not.** If you know that you're easily seduced by money and material comforts, write down some confessions below. Spend some time confessing your love of material comforts that prevents you from following God wholeheartedly.

**Reflection: Since the heart is the true repository of treasure, Jesus now indicates that when the eye focuses on something of value, it becomes the conduit that fills the heart with what has been focused upon.
