



### Day One

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

**You take the blue pill, the story ends and you wake up believing whatever you want to believe. You take the red pill, you stay in wonderland and I show you just how deep the rabbit hole goes. Why do you think we sometimes prefer lies to truth? What "truth" do you currently find it hard to accept in your life? Write some thoughts below.**

**Reflection: It's the choices that make us who we are, and we can always choose to do what's right.** What has the greatest influence upon the choices you make? Your background? Your environment, eg. friends, co-workers? The surrounding culture, eg. media? Your Christian belief? Think over what influences you most and write some thoughts above. Then, if there are influences that you know are not helping you follow Christ faithfully, confess them to God, and ask him for strength to make changes in the choices you make in your life. Prayer.

### Day Two

Listen to the episode. Read the following questions, and write your answers in the box provided.

**It's not the gifts per se that are a problem, but when they replace the righteousness that Jesus calls for in his sermon, we're in trouble.** Why do the more sensational gifts cause people to go astray? Are you ever tempted to admire leaders because of their charismatic gifts, rather than the quality of their lives? What can we do to avoid the dangers of being seduced by these gifts? Write some thoughts below.

**Reflection: He assumes that human beings are integrated wholes.** If this is true, then what kind of a person are you? Do you produce good fruit or bad fruit? Think over how you live your life. What kind of fruit are you producing? Write some specific examples above. Thank God for the fruit he is producing in your life, and ask him to show you specific areas you can still work on. Prayer.
