### She shall be called woman: Genesis 2.18-25

**1. Falling in love.** Ask the group when they first fell in love. What was it like?

**2. It is not good for man to be alone.** Who do you know who's lonely? How are you reaching out to them? Do you struggle with loneliness sometimes? Share as much as you're able with the group. This is a painful subject, but when such a topic is shared, we are better able to respond as a Christian community.

**3. We are designed for community, and men and women are designed for each other.** What are the implications of this statement? In our churches? In our society? In our own lives?

**4. Woman as partner. *Not made out of his head to top him, not out of his feet to be trampled upon by him, but out of his side to be equal with him, under his arm to be protected, and near his heart to be beloved.*** How do you respond to this quotation?

**5. *For this reason a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they will become one flesh.*** Read Matthew 19.5-6. I Corinthians 6.15-17. Ephesians 5.30-32. What are the implications of this sentence on the following? Choose one or more for discussion: Leaving home after marriage. Separating from one's parents. Divorce. Priorities within a marriage.
