**Courses!:** Genesis 3.14-24

1. ***The Apprentice.*** What do you think of shows that drive people to conflict? Helpful, harmful or just a waste of time?

2. ***The passage refers to the struggle between good and evil.*** How do you respond to movies like the Lord of the Rings, or The Chronicles of Narnia, with strong themes of good vs. evil? How do they challenge you?

3. ***For the woman, great pain in childbearing, from conception to birth.*** What do we learn through suffering? Is it an opportunity or a curse? And can it derail your spiritual life? Discuss.

4. ***Eve's desire for her husband.*** Domination or natural desire? However you view verse 16, what kinds of conflict dominate the relationship between men and women? How does a review of Genesis 2.21-23 help correct the distortion produced by the fall?

5. ***Without God, we're just dirt.*** Read Romans 8:18-20. Discuss the way you see the restoration of creation by God? OR ***Everything is broken here.*** What part does God call us to in fixing human relationships? If you have them, share stories of the redemption of human relationships? Why do they speak to us so deeply?
