**4. *Because the LORD disciplines those he loves, as a father the son he delights in.* How have you been disciplined by God? What is your reaction to the idea that God disciplines those he loves?**

**5. *Doubt as an expression of a life not fully committed either way.* Have you experienced times of doubt? And if so, how have you responded? How have you experienced God in times of doubt?**
